ATTENDANCE - Attending school every day is important for students to develop skills for life-long learning. There is a clear connection between going to school regularly and doing well in the classroom. Students aged 6 - 16 years are legally required to attend school every day.

The Ministry of Education (MOE) has set targets to improve student attendance across New Zealand schools as currently there are many students not attending school regularly. Aberdeen School has a Ministry Attendance Service Officer who will be working with us to ensure that all children are regularly attending school. Aberdeen School continues to engage with Bluelight Attendance Services to support us in lifting the attendance rates of students who are moderately and chronically absent.

If your child is away it is essential that you let the School Office know by phoning 07 8477 312, through the Skool Loop app or text 021 857 622. We need to know what date/s your child will be away and the reason for their absence.

As a school many hours are spent on attendance, and in classrooms teachers are working really hard to catch students up on learning activities they have missed out on due to absence. Please work in partnership with us by ensuring your child is at school on time every day.

Attendance Impacts on Time Spent at School Learning...

1 or 2 days a week does not seem much, but...
