

Phones Away for the Day: In order to comply with Government policy, Aberdeen School now has new requirements for those few students who bring their cellphones to school. From now on, students with phones must bring their cellphone to the school office when they arrive at school. One of the office ladies will then put the child's cellphone in a bag labelled with the child's name and room number. All student cellphones will be stored in a locked cupboard in the office during the day. Students can then come up to the office as they leave school to collect their cellphones. This process will start after the Easter break so please discuss these requirements with your child if they bring a cellphone to school ©

Easter Break: A reminder that all state schools will be closed on Tuesday the 2nd of April, after Easter weekend. School will resume for students on Wednesday next week following the Easter break ☺

Shoes for School: A reminder that at Aberdeen we ask that students wear predominately black shoes, boots, or sandals with their uniform. We do not mind if there is a bit of white or another colour on their black shoes. Black crocs are also allowed; however, we ask that jibbitz not be worn to school as students get upset if they get lost or taken.

Next term staff will be checking student footwear to ensure that predominately black footwear is worn to school. White or black socks or black/navy tights should be worn with our uniform.


