Shoes for School: Thank you to those families that have already adhered to our footwear requirements. Predominately black footwear should be worn to school. White or black socks or black/navy tights should be worn with our uniform. 😊

Parking Around the School: I have recently had neighbours' phone and email the school to let me know that cars are being parked across their driveways before and after school. 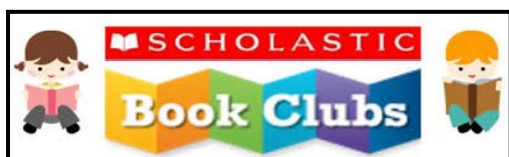

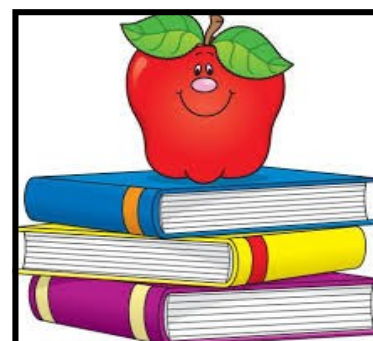
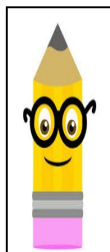
Lost and Found Property
